Glossary

Deck -- The skate deck is the flat board that you stand on when skateboarding. A shortboard, as opposed to a longboard or cruiser, is ideal for street skateboarding and vert skateboarding. It also remains the very best option for doing tricks, whether you are a beginner or a pro.

Helmet -- A helmet is a form of protective gear worn to protect the head from injuries. More specifically, a helmet aids the skull in protecting the human brain. Ceremonial or symbolic helmets without protective function are sometimes used.

Understand -- Understanding is a psychological process related to an abstract or physical object, such as a

person, situation, or message whereby one is able to think about it and use concepts to deal

Plastic -- Plastic is material consisting of any of a wide range of synthetic or semi-synthetic organic compounds that are malleable and so can be molded into solid objects.
